2016 Dodie Riach Memorial Scholarship

Purpose of Scholarship

The North Jersey Chapter of the Ninety-Nines Scholarship award is presented to a student pilot or pilot in recognition of earnest desire to further aviation achievements.

Selection Process

Any pilot or student pilot training in New Jersey is eligible to apply for the North Jersey Chapter of the Ninety-Nines Scholarship by completing the scholarship application form, obtaining a letter of recommendation and submitting the completed application requirements to the North Jersey Chapter of the Ninety-Nines, **postmarked no later than October 31, 2015.**

The Scholarship Committee, composed of both Ninety-Nines and active members of the aviation community in New Jersey with no connection to the Ninety-Nines, will review each application and determine the recipient.

Appropriateness of goals, expectations and relative need will be criteria used to determine the recipient.

The scholarship recipient will be announced at the annual North Jersey Chapter of the Ninety-Nines Holiday Dinner in December 2015.

Award

In 2016, two recipients will be awarded scholarships in the amount of \$3,000 each. Award winner(s) will be reimbursed for flight training expenses by submitting receipts to the North Jersey Chapter of the Ninety-Nines Scholarship Committee for audit and approval for reimbursement by the treasurer. The recipient must use the award by December 1, 2016.


